The WFMT course teaches basic understanding of wood science, wood floor finish types, and proper care and maintenance. Completion of this course will provide you the academic and hands on training to obtain WFMT certification. This certification will set you apart from competitors within the industry. There are currently wood flooring CCU courses available however; they do not hold the IICRC certification such as this course does.

Wood Floor Maintenance Technician (WFMT)

The Wood Floor Maintenance Technician course provides learn procedures, equipment, and materials required in wood floor maintenance. This will include chemicals, supplies (equipment, tools and materials) and commonly accepted service methodologies currently used in the industry. Students will learn some rudimentary basic knowledge concerning the materials used to manufacture wood flooring and how it impacts on site performance and maintenance procedures. (2 day course: 14 hours, not including exam time, lunch and breaks)
